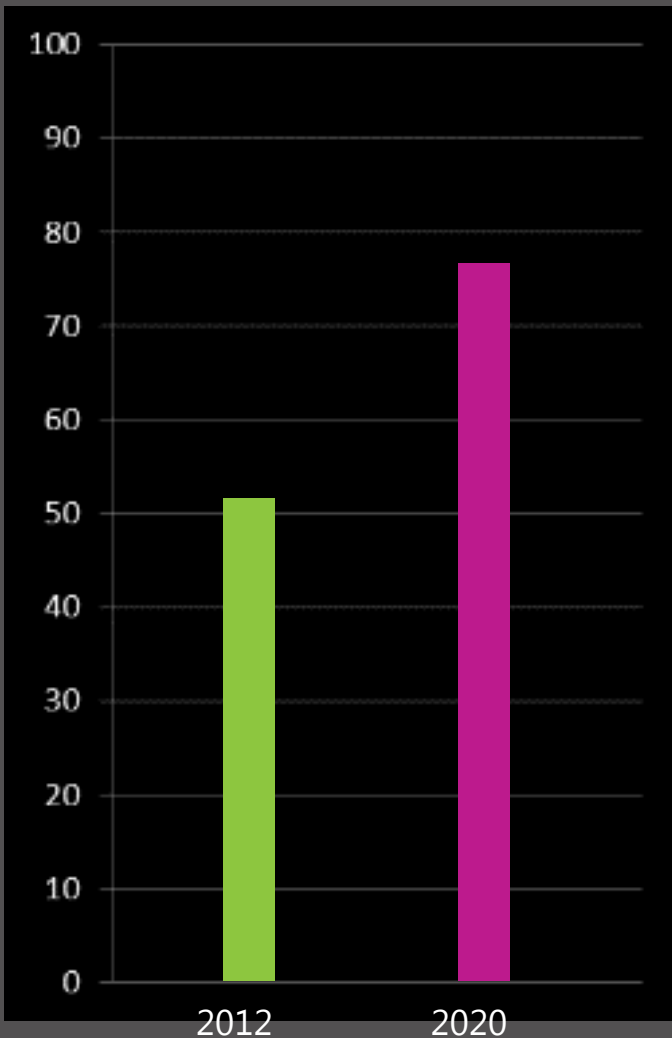

Jobs requiring IT skills (%)



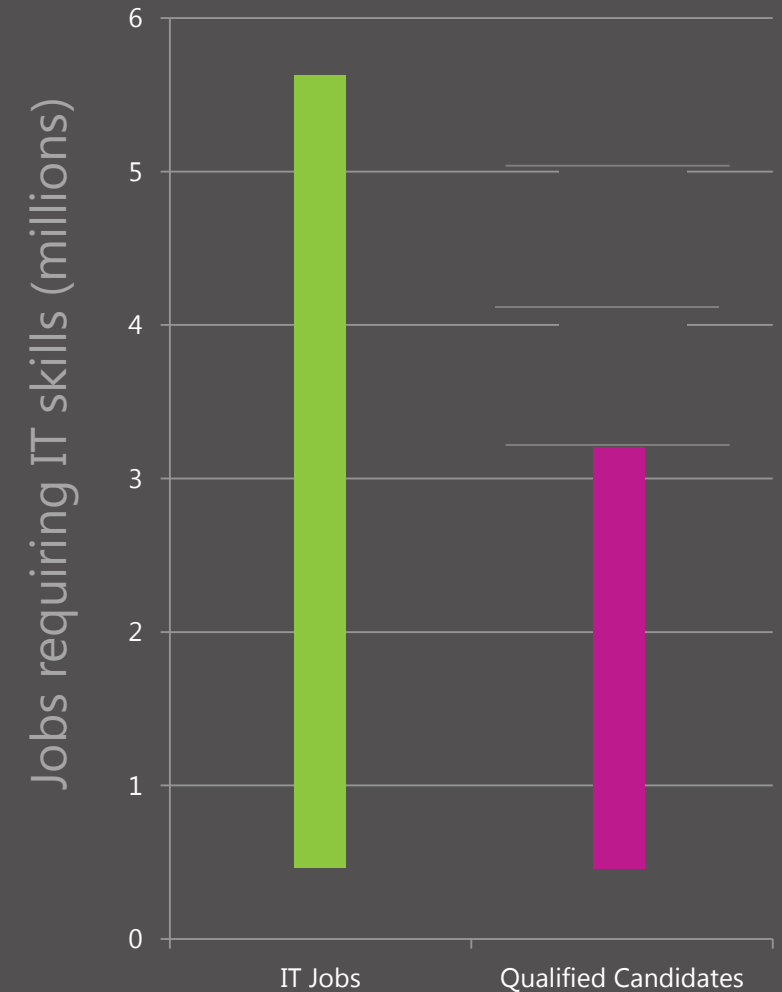

More than **50%** of today's jobs require some technology skills, and experts say that percentage will increase to **77%** in the next decade.



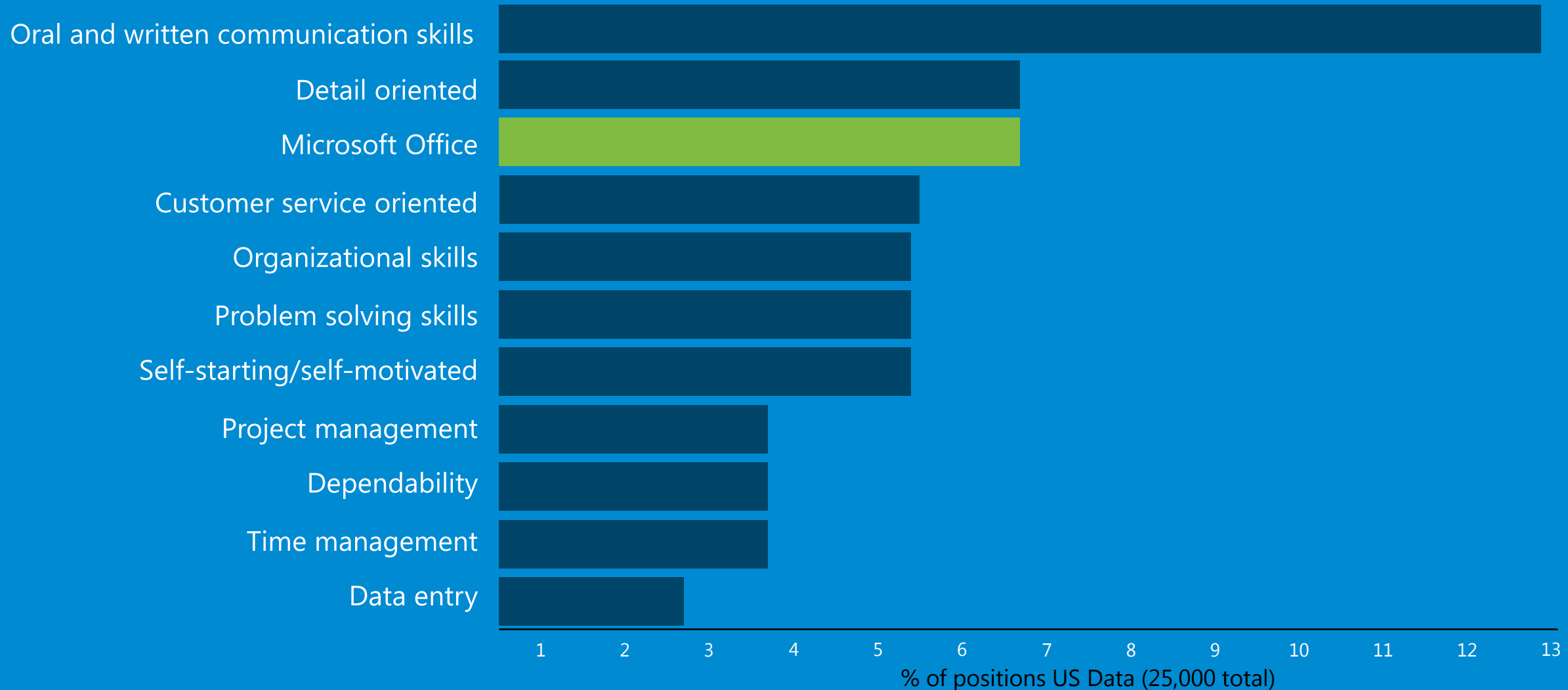

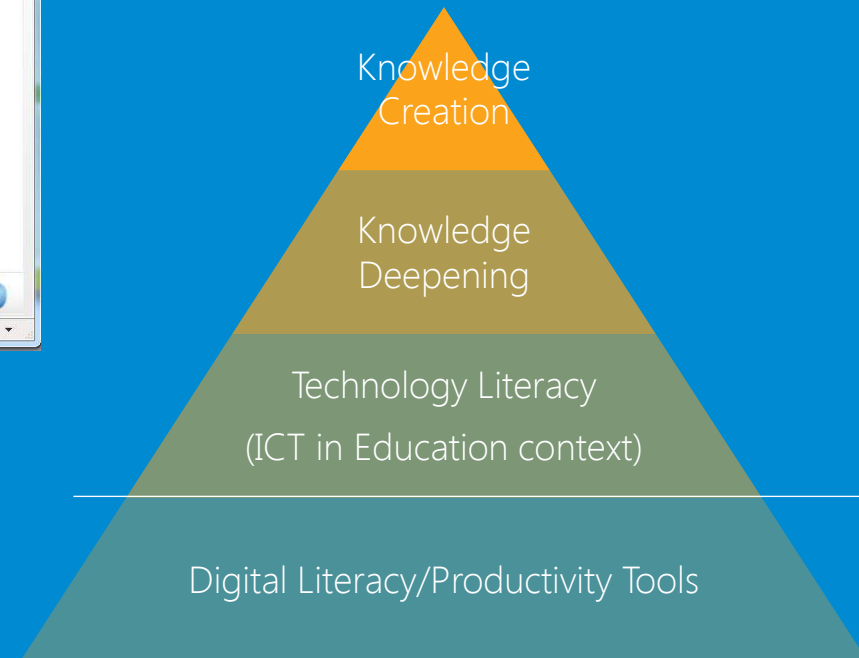
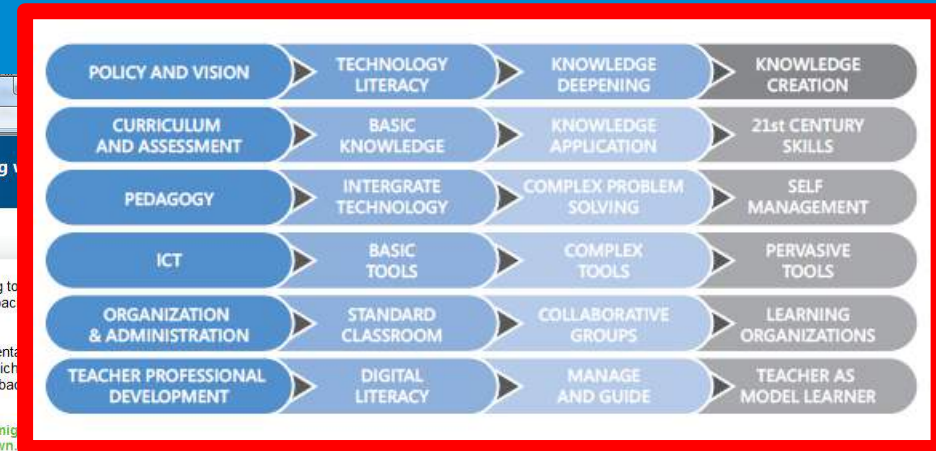


Why is ICT Integration So Hard?
